Cliff Railway Stations CAT, Machynlleth, Wales

Post & beam timber frame cliff railw ay stations, lecture room and offices. The cliff railw ay is w aterbalanced and brings visitors up 30m from the car park to the displays circuit.

The top station is perched on the edge of the slate tip, overlooking Snow donia National Park. The design uses Welsh 'green' oak for the platform structures w ith recycled pitch pine and homegrow n softw oods under a natural slate roof.

The lecture room and offices have a 'breathing', superinsulated construction of cellulose fibre, rendered w oodw ool slab and triple glazing in Pitch Pine joinery.
